

Department of Children and Families (DCF) Visits

Representatives of the Department of Children and Families (DCF) will schedule visits with Administration of this institution and will be allowed to visit their clients at time that has been pre-arranged.

- A. Supervised visits for children of the inmates at the House of Correction will take place on Monday and Tuesdays (between 9:00am – 10:30am. 11:45am – 4:00pm). Time to be determined in advanced by the Front Lobby Officer.
- B. DCF workers will provide their DCF State ID to the Lobby Officer and store personal items in the lockers provided, i.e., outerwear, cell phone, wallet, purse, etc.
- C. DCF workers will provide a copy of the birth certificate showing that the inmate is indeed the father of the child. In the event that the inmate is not on the birth certificate DCF will be given a form (Voluntary Acknowledgement of Parentage) which must be signed/notarized by both the mother and father of the child.
- D. Any item(s) needed for the visit will be presented to the Officer for inspection. If the DCF worker is transporting a child in a car seat/carrier, the Officer will request that the DCF worker hold the child while the carrier is inspected.
- E. In the event that an inmate is in lock up, the Lobby Officer will notify the social worker that the visit needs to be rescheduled.
- F. If there are any problems during the visit with the inmate the Correctional Officer has the right to terminate the visit.
